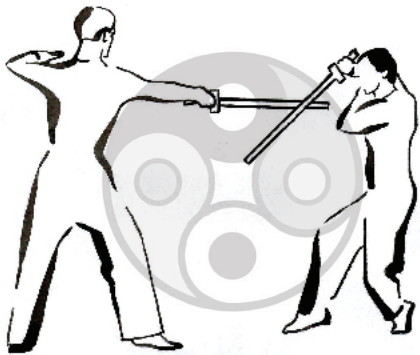

Full Circle Synergy School of T'ai Chi Ch'uan Presents: **CHINESE SWORDSMANSHIP**

Thousands practice Chinese sword forms, but few have trained in their actual martial use. Chinese swordsmanship in the modern era is almost a lost art. This seminar is a rare opportunity to study the art.

The seminar carries students from a basic understanding of how to use a blade in combat through the basic cuts to an elemental understanding of swordsmanship. Students learn proper grip and stance, basic cuts, two-man drills, and free swordplay, and leave with an understanding of Chinese swordsmanship.

While those who have previously studied a taiji jian form will find the techniques presented most familiar, all styles of Asian and European swordsmanship are welcome, regardless of background or skill level.

Scott is the Director of the Great River Taoist Center based in Washington, D.C., with branches in Baltimore and across Russia, Estonia and Finland.



He began teaching in the Soviet Union at the request of the Soviet Wushu Federation in 1991. In 1992 the Moscow school officially opened as a branch of Great River, with satellite groups later forming in other cities. While in Russia and Estonia, Scott has made TV programs about Yang Family Taijiquan and has been featured in various national publications.

He was also one of the first ten Americans to enter the door of the Jin Shan Pai, a traditional school of Taoist Nei Gong. Rodell, initiated into the Jin Shan Pai by Wang Yen-nien, is a sixth generation teacher in this tradition. Through the Center, local students in the Jin Shan Pai are working to create a Retreat Center for the development of Taoist practice.
